



Lets name the parts of the Ukelele



Lets name the parts of the Ukelele



1. Body – The big part that makes the sound. It vibrates when you strum the strings.
2. Neck – The long part you hold. It connects the body to the head.
3. Frets – The metal bars on the neck. They help you change the notes when you press the strings.
4. Headstock – The top part where the tuners are.
5. Tuners – The knobs you turn to tighten or loosen the strings (to tune them).
6. Strings – You strum or pluck these to make music.
7. Sound hole – The round hole in the body. It helps the sound come out louder.
8. Bridge – The piece on the body where the strings are attached at the bottom.
